## CSA Program

CSA stands for community supported agriculture. It is a way for farmers to share both the risks and joys of farming with members of the community. For an up-front fee, members become seasonal shareholders in the farm harvest. When you become a member of a CSA you commit yourself to supporting a farmer for a season. In turn, the farmer will provide you with a share of produce on a regular basis.

Most of the produce you will receive is from the farm and is certified organic. We will supplement with sweet corn, summer squash and potatoes from local Amish farmers (no spray). We pack the same produce for everybody but encourage shareholders to get to know and exchange with each other. You can choose the length of your season and the weeks you do not wish to receive produce. You have an open invitation to visit the farm, take a walk in our woods and see how your food is grown. We do like a call in advance and we will reserve Sunday as our family time. We end the season with a potluck and hoe-down at the farm.
